**BACGROUND:** The Wine Loft, West Broad Village is celebrating its grand opening by challenging Richmonders to feed at least 100 at-risk children.

For every bottle of Virginia wine sold between now and the end of the school year, the Wine Loft will sponsor a weekend backpack of food for an at risk child. Of critical importance to the CVFB is stopping childhood hunger. Poverty and food insecurity negatively influence the diet and health of many low-income children. Weekend backpacks are delivered to children at risk of hunger in Richmond, Henrico, and Chesterfield schools. The BackPack Program is designed to meet the needs of hungry children at times when other resources are not available, such as weekends and school vacations.

## About the BackPack Program

- Backpacks filled with food that children take home on weekends
- Food is child-friendly, nonperishable and easily consumed.
- Backpacks are discreetly distributed to children on the last day before the weekend or holiday vacation
